

## IOWA SEES SUFFRAGETTES.

600 Led by the Rev. Anna Shaw, Parade  
for Boone's Benefit

BOONE, Iowa, Oct. 29.—Six hundred women suffragists paraded the streets of Boone to-day. The Rev. Anna Shaw, head of the National Order of Suffragists, headed the parade. With her were Miss Rendell and Miss Costello of London, famous for their participation in the attacks made on Parliament by the Suffragettes of England.

The spectacle of 600 women marching through the streets caused the whole town to turn out to see and admire.
