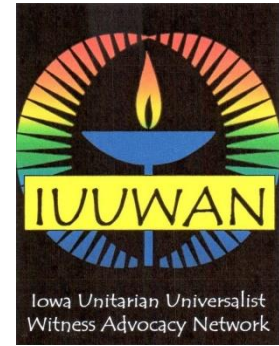


# Outreach Organizer

## Iowa Unitarian Universalist Witness & Advocacy Network (IUUWAN)

*Closing date for applications is August 10, 2021*



The Outreach Organizer will build relationships between Iowa Unitarian Universalist Witness and Advocacy Network (IUUWAN) and Unitarian Universalist congregations in Iowa and will organize UU congregations into a unified effort to expand our social justice advocacy actions in the state.

The Outreach Organizer will work 20 hours per week and will be paid \$20 per hour. This is a nine month position beginning after August 1 with the potential for continued employment. The Outreach Organizer will report to the IUUWAN Board of Directors.

### **The responsibilities of the Outreach Organizer will include but not be limited to:**

- Strengthen ties between IUUWAN and social justice teams/church boards in each Iowa UU congregation.
- Assess each congregation's current social justice endeavors and their interests and goals.
- Collaborate to create a short and long term plan for organizing all UU groups into collaborative social justice advocacy movements in the state.
- Develop a communication plan for IUUWAN including email notifications, Facebook postings, web page and bi-monthly newsletters.
- Attend monthly IUUWAN Board of Directors meetings and report on tasks conducted to date and progress toward goals set by the Board.
- Introduce IUUWAN to other liberal religious organizations and other relevant Iowa social justice groups. Strengthen or begin to form collaborative partnerships with these groups.
- Organize a conference related to the social justice goals of UU congregations with invitations to all other partner groups.
- Introduce IUUWAN to Iowa state legislators and organize a UU Advocacy Day related to the social justice issue identified in the assessment as of most concern to UUs.
- Develop a membership structure and financial stability plan for IUUWAN.

### **The ideal candidate will have these qualifications:**

- community organizing skills
- knowledge of Unitarian Universalism or other liberal religions
- social media skills
- knowledge of the legislative process
- written and verbal communication skills
- ability to work with people of various ages and backgrounds

The Outreach Organizer will work from home utilizing their own computer and phone.. Travel is anticipated with appropriate mileage reimbursement. Benefits to be negotiated with the board include sick days, and paid time off for holidays.
